The entertainments which were given to us on winter evenings can only be described as vapid. Drama was always popular, and probably the peasant can receive art in this manner more easily than in any other. When Goethe was asked how the German language and art might be fostered in Poland, he answered, Not so much by schools and books, but by travelling companies that will give homely little plays to interest the villagers. My early experiences were sad. We asked for bread and were given stones; the only plays supplied being insipid stories about the squire s son and the vicar s daughter, with a chorus of mythically respectful peasantry. This was very disheartening, because we required entertainment in the long winter...
